Re Installation of skylights at Frankston Basketball Centre

I trust this letter finds you well. I am writing to convey on behalf of Frankston & District Basketball Association our sincere thanks for the recent installation of skylights on two of our indoor courts at Frankston Basketball Centre (90 Bardia Ave, Seaford).

The immediate impact this recent installation has had on this area is profound and the long-term savings our association will achieve through less power consumption will be significant.

As you are aware, our association is one of the fifth largest basketball associations in Australia with over 13,000 participants annually involved in various grades of competitions; grass roots development; and all abilities programs. Our association is also an employer of choice for over 130 referees many of which are aged 15-18 years old.

Frankston Basketball is the regional hub for basketball on the Mornington Peninsula and with our strong partnership with Frankston City Council our association continues to evolve in the pursuit of our vision of being 'the leader in community sports.'

The installation of new skylights is only the start of transforming this two court area into a space which fosters grassroots and elite athlete development. Over the coming months further initiatives will be taking place which will include the installation of external basketball courts and a well-being & conditioning area.

It is hoped this new space will be officially launched during the period of the association hosting the National South Sudanese Basketball Tournament over the weekend of December 21 & 22. I will send a formal invite to yourself and Frankston City Mayor Sandra Mayer to attend this event over the coming weeks.

Lastly, I have included images of the visual impact the new installation has delivered for this two court area for your reference and look forward to walking you through the area next time you visit our facility. It is hoped the remaining four indoor courts can have similar skylights installed over the coming 12 months.

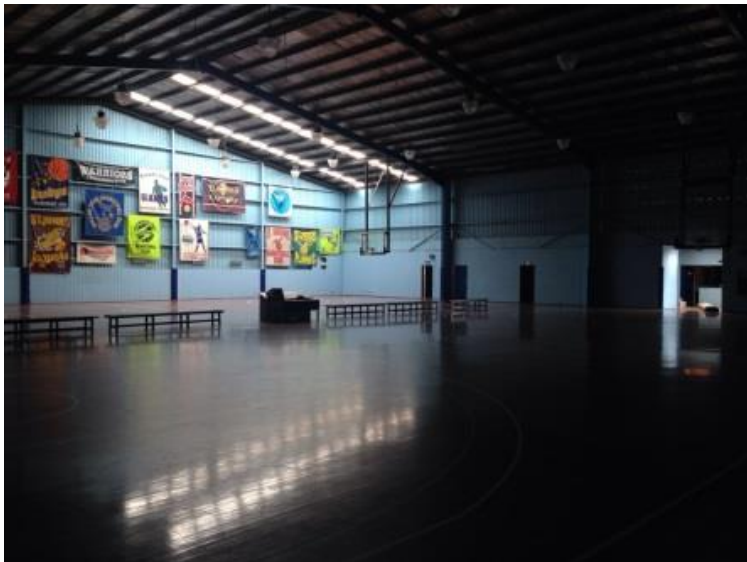


Image 2: 3 skylight panels installed

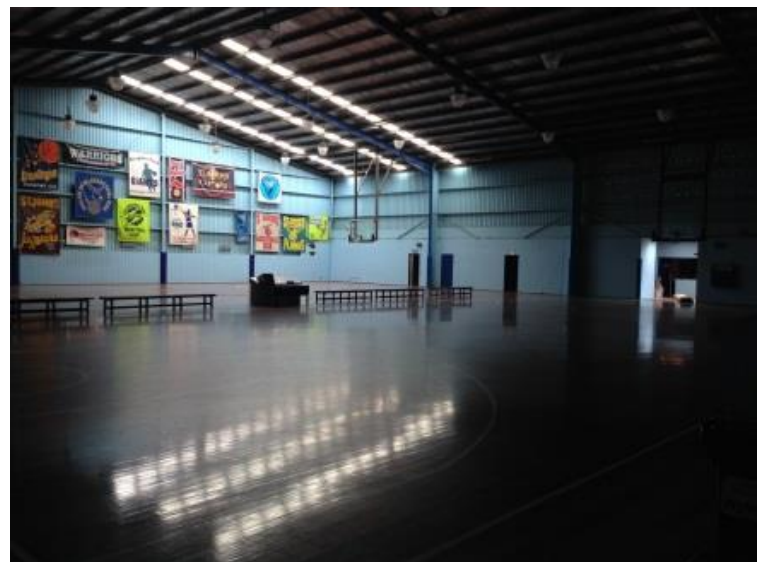


Image 3: 6 skylight panels installed

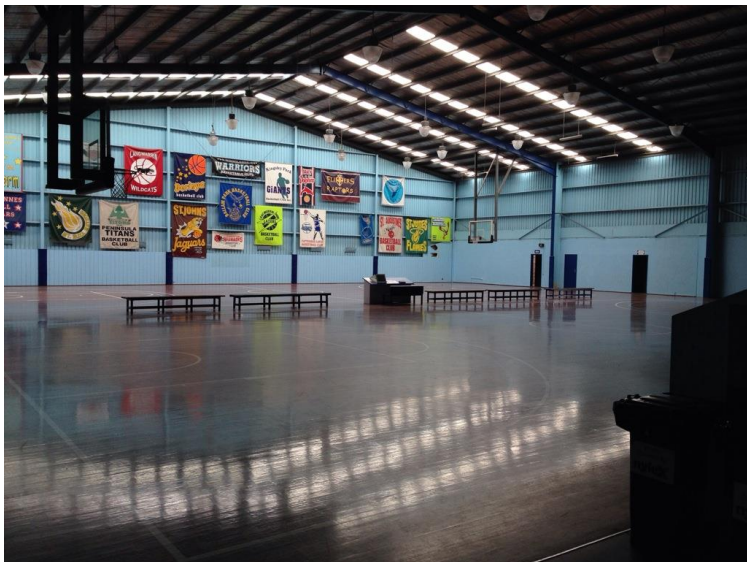


Image 4: skylight installation complete
